Charge Person Responsibilities

- Conduct an initial assessment of the injury.
- Designate someone to watch the other participants (stop all activities and ensure all participants are in a safe area if nobody is available to supervise).
- Wait with the injured participant and help keep them calm until emergency medical services arrive and conduct their assessment of the injury.
- Record the injury using the Port Moody Soccer Club's Accident Report Form.

Call Person Responsibilities

- Call for emergency help.
- Provide all necessary information to dispatch:
 - The facility location.
 - The closest access to the injured participant.
 - The nature of the injury.
 - A description of first aid that has been performed.
 - Other medical information, such as allergies or medical conditions.
- Clear any traffic from the facility entrance or access road before the emergency vehicles arrive.
- Wait by the entrance to direct the emergency services.
- Call the participant's emergency contact person.
- Ensure to communicate any critical information to Emergency Services and / or 911 dispatch.
- Assist the Charge Person as needed.
